Is vaccinating dangerous?

- ✔ The human genome is not changed by the vaccine.
- ✔ Vaccination has no effect on the fertility of men and women.
- ✔ No chip is administered with the vaccine.
- ✔ There is no alcohol in the vaccine.
- ✔ Vaccination has no influence on your stay in Germany – vaccination is a private matter.
